

Permitt Terms: 1. Por the duration of the Work the Permittee shall have an approved copy of the permit, uraffic control plan, and City-approved drawings at the work site at all times. 2. Duration of the permit will be set at the time of issuance of the permit, If work is not completed within the approved time frame, the permit will expire. An extension may be applied for prior to permit expiration and must be issued in writing prior to commencement of any further work. 3. If the Engineer or assigned representative determines construction practices and/or materials do not meet City specifications or if the Permittee fails to comply with the conditions of the permit, the Engineer may suspend the permit, stop work, order the removal and replacement of faulty work, require extension of the warranty period, or other conditions. 4. Permittee shall notify the Public Works Department tow (2) working days in advance of work to be performed. If notification is not given permit is immediately revoked and all work activities will cease immediately. 5. Permittee shall notify the Public Works Department one (1) working day before any required inspection. Before burying any subsurface infrastructure (i.e. pipeline or fittings). Permittee shall notify the Public Works Department to allow for inspection and GPS-survey of all items to document location. Items huried without City approval will be re-exervated by the Permittee at no additional cost to the City. 4.
